About Counterpoint Tactical System

The Counterpoint Tactical System, also known by the acronym CTS, is a weapon-based integrated martial art designed for the street with an emphasis on real-world tactical counter offense. Although an eclectic martial art, the Counterpoint Tactical System's largest traditional influence can be found in the Filipino Martial Arts. The purpose of CTS is to train and certify students and instructors, making them well versed in every phase of civilian armed and unarmed combat. Counterpoint Tactical System is unmatched in the fighting arts for its span of techniques: covering punching, kicking, trapping, long-range and short-range weapon applications and defense, stand-up grappling, and ground fighting

About Cacoy Doce Pares Eskrima

Eskrima is a Filipino Martial art and is also the National Sport of the Philippines. Eskrima's focuses on the use of weapons both in reality applications and for sport competition. Cacoy Doce Pares Eskrima is an independent system of Eskrima created by the late Supreme Grandmaster Cacoy Canete. It is best known for its "close curving" techniques and its specialized grappling technique set "Eskrido" which features throws with the use of a stick.

Code of Conduct

- Practice cleanliness and order. The condition of your school is a reflection of its students, be proud of your reflection.
- Always listen attentively to the instructor. Raise your hand if you have a question and wait patiently for the answer.
- Come early to class. It is always a good idea to give yourself extra time. Prompt and regular attendance shows respect to your instructor and fellow students.
- Train at the level of their partner. Black belts should slow down for the white belts, remember you were a white belt once yourself.
- Remember that your actions outside the school reflect its character and spirit. You are an ambassador of your school. Always behave appropriately with good manners and respect.
